

Can Name Ending Sound of a Simple Word. (L1)

Strategy to teach skill: Clearly announce the ending sound of a word to the point of bouncing the ending sound of the word and ask your child to repeat the ending sound that he or she hears when you say the word.

For example:

hog g g
stop p p
pass s s
wet t t
ring g g

Once your child gets the hang of identifying sound when ending sound is bounced, try just emphasizing the ending sound of the word and seeing if your child can identify the ending sound of the word:

For example:

sun
car
top
net
fish
what
bam
clock

Once your child gets the hang of identifying sound when ending sound is emphasized, practice saying word normally and seeing if your child can identify the ending sound of the word:

cat
dog
star
will
fun
& etc.

Practice this skill 1 to 2 minutes per day until your child has learned the skill. Want this skill learned to mastery- child can identify ending sound, from word spoken normally, correctly day after day.

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
