

(P3) Learning About Letters: Lower Case Line Dance
& Small, Tall, and Under the Line Playdough Letters

Learning about letters takes time and practice. Sometimes it is the fun & silly activities that makes the mental connection.

Lower Case Line Dance- help your child dance to remember each letter's position on the page's line. Start out always having a written alphabet for quick reference. Once your child can do the dance just by saying the letter & its attribute (small, tall, or under the line), then your child has mastery of this skill.
