

Names the medial sounds of simple, three letter words

Practice this skill by first asking your child to:

1. Listen carefully for the middle sound in the word you are going to say twice.
2. Then say the word normally and then immediately repeat the word over enunciating the vowel sound in each word.
3. Practice 5 or so at a time.

Practice words such as these daily until your child can repeat the vowel sound correctly without hesitation.
