

**Writes 39 or more, upper and/or lower case letters,
correctly & consistently from memory**

Strategy to teach skill: As a warm up, ask child to write entire alphabet looking at alphabet (next page). This primes a child's memory. Then cover & ask child to write as many letters as they can from memory on this page. Goal: 39 letters, no errors.
